

# Notification of a deceased person

Use this form to officially notify us of a person's death. If you are the legal personal representative, for example executor with grant of probate or court-appointed administrator, you can also use this form to add your contact details on the deceased person's record.

## Before you complete this form

You can officially notify us of a person's death and who has been appointed as the legal personal representative:

- online if you are able to attend one of the participating Australia Post retails outlets, go to ato.gov.au/austpostformdeceased, or
- phone if you don't have the death certificate you can phone us on 13 28 61 and we may still be able to add some information about the person's death to our records.

#### When completing this form

This form can be completed on screen. When complete, print, sign and date the declaration at the end of the form.

Make sure you provide acceptable supporting documents (see question 9).

If completing this form by hand:

- print clearly in BLOCK LETTERS using a black or dark blue pen only
- place X in ALL applicable boxes
- do not use correction fluid or covering stickers
- sign next to any corrections with your full signature (not initials).

If you phone, we need to know we are talking to the right person before we can discuss the tax affairs of someone who has died.
